WELCOME TO IMMERSE ARTISTS EXPERIENCE!

We are thrilled to welcome you to Immerse Artists Experience in **BIRMINGHAM**! Our entire faculty and staff are truly honored that you have chosen to join us. Get ready for a day filled with dynamic, engaging classes and an unmatched IAX vibe!

Throughout the day, you can expect positive energy, incredible choreography, interactive technique sessions, and an encouraging atmosphere. To make the most of your experience, please review this welcome packet in advance. It contains all the essential details for your IAX event. Being prepared in advance will allow you to relax, enjoy the day, and make the most of everything IAX has to offer.

REGISTRATION

Doors open at 7:00 AM. We kindly ask that attendees do not arrive earlier than 7:00 AM. Check-in will take place next to the **EAST BALLROOM** in our lobby near the IAX Pop-Up Shop, on **Sunday morning from 7:00–7:20 AM**. Please arrive before 7:20 AM to complete check-in. (The East Ballroom entrance is located diagonally across from the Sheraton.)

We ask that **one representative per account** visit the registration table to receive dancer ID numbers and wristbands. Wristbands are for studio owners, teachers, and observers only. Each dancer's name will be on the back of their number. Account holders will receive their registered attendee list via email before the event; **no printed list will be provided onsite**.

Dancers registered through their studio **do not need to visit the check-in table**. Instead, they should check in with their studio owner, teacher, or assigned studio representative. We recommend studios designate a meeting time and place in advance to distribute wristbands and numbers. **Dancers should bring safety pins** to attach their numbers.

Please note: Immerse Artists Experience hosts **private events**. Everyone in attendance — including dancers, teachers, studio owners, studio representatives, and observers — must be registered and agree to the terms and conditions found on our website and in our waiver.

WAIVERS

All attendees (dancers, teachers, studio owners, studio representatives, observers, etc.) are required to electronically sign the **"Release and Waiver of Liability and Use of Likeness Agreement"** before the event. *Studio owners cannot sign waivers on behalf of students, teachers, or observers. Each waiver requires an individual email address as the legal identifier.*

A waiver link will be emailed to the **account holder from Dance Bug Support** two weeks before the event. The account holder is responsible for forwarding the link to all registered attendees. The process is simple and quick.

A **signed electronic waiver is required** to receive wristbands and enter the event.

Please do not print, email, or bring a paper waiver to the event. All waivers must be electronically signed through the **Dance Bug link** by the deadline. event. All waivers must be electronically signed through the Dance Bug link by the deadline date.



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WRISTBANDS

All **observers and studio staff** registered to attend will receive a wristband. Wristbands must be worn and **visible at all times** during the event.

Parent/guardian observers may only enter their dancer's **designated ballroom** during classes. Rooms will be routinely checked to ensure dancer safety. Anyone **without a wristband** will be kindly asked to leave the room.

Observer wristbands will only be available for purchase at the event for \$50, **if space allows**. To purchase one, the buyer will be asked security questions and must sign a waiver.

Dancers must wear their number at all times. This serves as their pass into the ballroom.

WRISTBAND COLOR CODE

Black wristbands will be issued to studio owners and teachers, while blue wristbands will be given to observers.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Dancers are expected to be kind, supportive, respectful, and on time. They should demonstrate strong work ethic and good sportsmanship throughout the event. It is our goal for everyone to have fun, grow, and make friends in a positive and uplifting environment.

It is expected that all observers will be respectful and courteous at all times. Please refrain from talking during classes or causing any disruptions. Observers should find a chair and remain seated during all class sessions. **Sitting on the floor is not permitted.**

Although we discourage young siblings from attending as observers, we understand that it may sometimes be necessary. **Wristbands will be required for young siblings if they occupy a chair.** Like all observers, **young siblings may not sit on the floor, and spreading out blankets or creating floor setups is not allowed.** All attendees must remain seated in chairs during classes. If a young sibling becomes restless or disruptive, we kindly ask that you step into the lobby to help maintain a focused and respectful environment for the dancers.

DANCERS, PLEASE DO NOT PLACE PERSONAL ITEMS IN THE CHAIRS. ALL CHAIRS ARE RESERVED FOR REGISTERED OBSERVERS. If chairs have not been placed along an air wall, this indicates that **personal items should not be stored in that area.**

CHANGING AGE DIVISIONS / REGISTRATION UPDATES

Please take a moment to review your registration, including age divisions, to ensure all information is correct. Any changes or corrections must be submitted no later than one week before the event. Changes cannot be made during the week of the event. If a dancer needs to be moved to a different level on the day of the event, the request must come directly from the studio owner and must be made by the second class of the day. Level changes are only possible if space allows. No adjustments can be made to rooms that are sold out.

FOOD AND DRINK POLICY

Immerse Artists Experience does not provide food or beverages. All attendees are responsible for bringing their own water bottles and purchasing their own lunch. Please note that, in accordance with venue regulations, food, sports drinks, and sodas are not allowed inside the ballrooms at any time. Only water is permitted.



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CONCESSIONS / LUNCH INFORMATION

Concessions will not be available during our event at the BJCC. Please ensure your dancer has appropriate lunch arrangements by either sending a lunch with them or bringing one at the start of the designated lunch break. Please be respectful of others and the event center by properly disposing of all trash and placing it in the designated receptacles.

PARKING

Parking at the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex is \$20 per entry.

PHOTO / VIDEO POLICY

For the safety of our dancers, the protection of faculty choreography, and to minimize distractions, **photography and video recording by attendees is strictly prohibited in all classes**, regardless of device type (including cell phones and cameras). This policy will be **actively enforced**. Our faculty and staff reserve the right to remove anyone found recording or taking photos without permission — **no refunds or credits will be issued**.

Attendee photography is permitted only during **scholarship announcements**. If an instructor chooses to allow video recording during class, they will announce it at the appropriate time. Please note that **photos with faculty will not be available after class**, as they are on a tight schedule. Opportunities to take **photos with faculty will be offered during the lunch break and after the event**.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY – ONLY \$7

To ensure a safe, stress-free, and professional environment, a **professional photographer** will be onsite to capture event moments and memories. Photos will be available for preview and purchase by clicking the **PHOTO** link on our website. These high-quality photos are available for **just \$7 each**. Please allow up to two weeks for photos to be uploaded and made available online.

Each city's photo gallery is password protected. Please contact your studio owner or account holder for the password. The password was provided in your city's Event Information email.

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SCHOLARSHIPS

Our distinguished Immerse Artists Experience faculty will be awarding a variety of scholarships throughout the event. These may include:

- **IAX Elite** – Full scholarship for all cities during the current and following season, including the opportunity to assist
- **Outstanding Artist** – \$75 scholarship for one city during the following season
- **Captivating Artist** – \$50 scholarship for one city during the following season

Additional scholarships may also be awarded for the **San Francisco Tap Festival, TMilly, Broadway Dance Center, Millennium Dance Complex – Nashville, Performer's Edge Coaching, AOM, and Jo+Jax.**

The faculty will determine **which scholarships** and **how many** are awarded at each city. This will vary by location, and all scholarship decisions are final. Scholarships are **non-transferable**, have an **expiration date**, and **cannot be redeemed for cash.**
